

Project: Family Activities

Materials: Notebook, pencil, or pen, family photos, tape recorder, or video camera.

Directions: See below.

- * Listen to a story and create a story book with everyone in the family helping.
- * Make a family story album using photos and stories from your parents and grandparents.
- * Tape record, or video tape, a story that has happened to you.
- * Tape record, or video tape, a story that happened to your parent or grandparent.
- * Tape record, or video, a story that happened to your whole family. Let everyone have a turn telling it.
- * Make a list of all of the animals you can remember in the stories on the tape. Did you have more on your list than Mom or Dad?
- * Listen to a story and tell what you liked best about the story.
- * Can you find rhyming words in any of the stories? Can you find words that would rhyme with the animals in the stories? Example: Skunk-Bunk Owl-Howl.
- * Make a movie using your video camera of your favorite story. Don't forget costumes.
- * Tell an animal story that happened to you.
- * What pets did your parents or grandparents have when they were growing up
